DISCLOSURE STATEMENT FOR PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE AND CERTIFICATION

Notice to Students Re: Professional Licensure and Certification

CNI College provides disclosure to students pursuing professional licensure and certification. Federal regulations require higher education programs that offer professional licensure and certification to disclose whether the program meets licensure and certification requirements in other states. The disclosure is presented publicly, on the CNI College Website, and individually to students in the application packet, prior to enrollment. In order to comply with Title IV federal student aid eligibility, state authorization requires educational institutions to be authorized in the state in which they are located.

CNI College's programs for professions that require licensure or certification are intended to prepare students for California licensure and certification requirements. Program admission does not guarantee that students will obtain a license or certification. Requirements for licensure and certification are established by agencies that are not controlled or affiliated with CNI College and may be subject to change.

CNI College has not determined whether its programs meet other states' educational or professional requirements for licensure and certification. Students planning to pursue licensure or certification in other states are responsible for determining whether, if they complete a CNI College program, that they will meet their state's requirements for licensure or certification.
